What is The Academy?

Simply put, it is a series of 12 courses designed to develop well-equipped, thoughtful people to better serve councils in a variety of capacities. For some this may lead to becoming

commissioned ruling elders (CREs) while others delight in learning and growing as a leader. We are lining up some of the finest instructors we can find!

Where will this be held?

Each summer two classes will be held at the Synod School of the Synod of Lakes and Prairies at Buena Vista University in Storm Lake, IA.

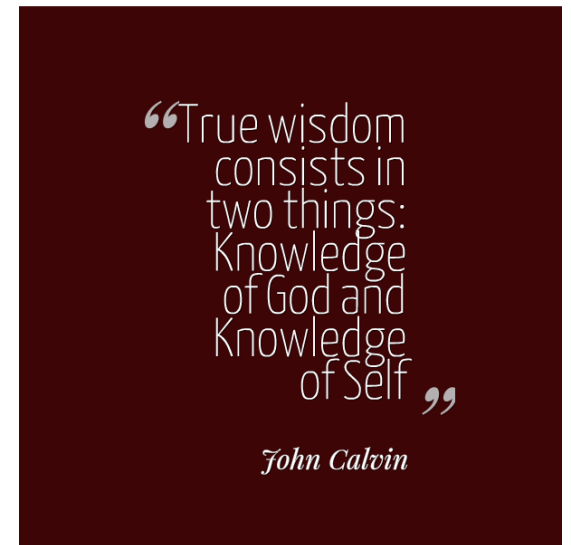
Beginning in 2025, in collaboration with the Omaha Presbyterian Seminary Foundation (OPSF), foundational courses will be shared as a part of their Lilly Grant. This enables Academy participants to also get a Certificate in Compelling Preaching.

What is the cost to me?

Tuition: If you are a member of a participating presbytery, the tuition is \$1,375/person for all 11 courses (which will fulfill the educational requirements to become a CRE). If your presbytery is not a partner, each class will be \$175 or \$1,925. *This may decrease, depending on arrangements with OPSF.*

Other expenses: Each participant will purchase required books, pay annually for room and board at Synod School

(approximately \$290/double or \$390/single), as well as travel and room/board expenses for Fall and Spring classes. The Synod of Lakes and Prairies will provide a Synod School scholarship of \$100/summer for Academy participants (already calculated in the prices above).
